

TGE was awarded the order of PMC Services for Map Ta Phut LNG Terminal in Thailand

Tokyo Gas Engineering Co, Ltd. (President: Mr. Keiji Aihara, and hereinafter referred to as “TGE”) is awarded the order for PMC Services for Phase II expansion of Map Ta Phut LNG Receiving Terminal in Thailand from PTTLNG Company Limited. It is the first time that Japanese engineering company is awarded the order of PMC for such big scale project of LNG receiving terminal in overseas.

Map Ta Phut LNG Terminal is the first LNG receiving terminal in Thailand. The capacity for Phase I is 5MMTPA and 10MMTPA for Phase II. TGE has been contributing to PTTLNG through engineering work for this terminal from Phase I. At Phase II, TGE was awarded for FEED and EPC contractor selection. TGE, a member of Tokyo Gas group has been admitted by PTTLNG through the engineering performance as an extensive experience of engineering, procurement, construction and operation of numerous LNG receiving terminals in Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd. as well as other domestic and overseas LNG projects.

EPC contractor for Phase II is planned to be awarded around the beginning of February, 2014, and EPC work will be finished by the end of March, 2017.

TGE will continue positively working on plant engineering area to achieve “Challenge 2020 Vision”.
